## JRC SUMMER PROGRAM RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

**Please read through all of the Rules and Requirements listed below. All Rules and Requirements WILL BE enforced.**

1. All children MUST participate in swimming and have a labeled towel, bathing suit, water bottle and backpack daily. \*Medical excuses are needed otherwise. PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH NAME!!
2. Children MUST be toilet trained, MUST be able to change their own clothes without assistance, and MUST be able to transition on their own with counselor direction.
3. All children MUST have socks and sneakers! NO Sandals, NO Crocs, No flip-flops! Children have P.E. every day and need to have sneakers for safety. \*No exceptions\*
4. We expect that all children demonstrate care, respect, and responsibility at all times while at summer program.
5. We also expect children to exhibit self-control, be nice to others, and follow simple instructions given by counselors, life guards and Directors.
6. There is no fighting allowed and no inappropriate language allowed!
7. Electronics are NOT ALLOWED! This includes cell phones and smart watches. We have phones at the school for emergencies and you can always contact Debra Mills via cell phone.
8. We expect that those that are riding a bus do so with respect and follow bus rules. Bus riding in the summer is a privilege not mandatory. Students will be removed from bus privileges for repetitive issues.
9. Participation in all JRC stations (Swimming, P.E., and Arts and Crafts/Games) is MANDATORY! There are many options available to choose from. Children will not be allowed to sit out of anything unless there is a medical reason. Please DO NOT send your children if they don't want to be here, it makes the day uncomfortable for all.
10. Please do not allow children to bring toys, cards, or stuffed animals of any kind. We will NOT be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged belongings.

We have a 3-strike rule for those that do not follow the JRC Summer Program Rules and Requirements.

1. After 2 verbal warnings given by counselor, life guard, or Director. Parents will be called and asked to pick up their child. Depending on infraction severity, child may be asked not to attend summer program the next day.
2. After 3 infractions of child being sent home, we will require removal from the JRC Summer Program.
3. Any violence to others, hate speech, bullying, or destruction of property is an immediate removal from the JRC Summer Program.
